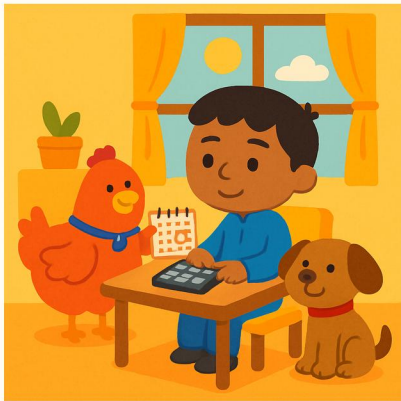

A social story for Kairav — managing test anxiety and using accommodations on exam day

time for my test.

and Avaz ready. I read each  
question slowly.

When I feel stuck, I can  
skip to the next question. I  
go back later.

All done! I did my best.  
That is always enough.

# Mistakes Help Me Learn

A social story for Kairav — Learning that making mistakes is normal and okay, and how to handle frustration when things go wrong



1

I am doing my homework with Gigi. We write our answers carefully.



2

Gigi's answer was wrong. She feels hot and frustrated. That is okay.



3

I press 'help' on my Avaz. Milo comes to help us.



4

Milo gives us an eraser. We can try again. Wrong answers are okay.



5

Mistakes help my brain learn. I am proud when I try again.

# I Need A Break

A social story for Kairav — Learning to recognize when I need a break and how to ask for one



1

My body feels full. Too much is happening around me.



2

I can tap 'break' on my Avaz. I can tell someone I am tired.



3

Teacher says 'okay, five minutes!'. She understands what I need.



4

I go to my quiet corner. I can breathe slowly and rest.



5

Soon I feel better. I can go back to my work. Thank you for helping me.

# My Quiet Helper

A social story for Kairav — Using headphones when the classroom feels too loud



1

My classroom has many sounds. Talking and fans and chairs moving. Sometimes it feels loud.



2

The loud sounds make me feel full in my head. That is okay. I can ask for help.



3

I can show my teacher my headphones card. I can ask for my quiet helper.



4

I put on my headphones. The sounds get quiet and soft. Now I can learn.



5

My head feels better now. My teacher is happy I asked for help. I am learning well.
