A social story for Kairav — Managing loud music and crowds at a family wedding celebration

Tonight is cousin didi's sangeet. There will be music and dance.

The music will be loud. The lights will be bright. That might feel overwhelming.

I can wear my ear defenders. They help make the loud sounds quiet.



4

I can wave at cousin didi. I can watch the dance for a short visit.



5

When I need quiet, I can go to my hotel room. I was part of the celebration.

Many Relatives Day

A social story for Kairav — handling large family gatherings with many relatives visiting

Today many family people come to my house. Aunties and uncles and cousins are here.

The talking gets loud. The sounds feel too many. That is okay to feel.



3

Gigi shows me the quiet room. I can go there when I need a break.



4

I use my Avaz to say hello and goodbye. My words help me talk to family.

Papa gives me my favorite food on a small plate. When I feel tired, I can tell Papa we go home.

Quiet Room Please

A social story for Kairav — asking for a break when overwhelmed by noise and crowds

There are many people talking. The sounds feel too big for my head.

My body tells me I need something. I feel full in my head.



3

I can tap on my Avaz. I can ask for quiet room please.



4

Mummy finds a quiet room for me. I can sit here for ten minutes.



5

My head feels better now. I can go back when I am ready.

This Is My Talker

A social story for Kairav — Introducing and explaining AAC device to new people

Gigi brings her cousin Bruno to meet me. I have my talker with me.



2

This is my talker. It helps me talk to friends.



3

I tap the buttons to make words. My talker speaks for me.



4

Bruno is curious about my talker. He wants to listen.



5

Bruno waits for me to use my talker. Now we can be good friends.
